Our spring Revival will be May 16-19. Mark these important dates on your calendar. The Bible says in Hebrews 3: 12, "Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; but exhort one another daily, while it is called 'Today,' lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin." We must guard our hearts against the tendency to depart from our God. The reason that we need to be revived is that we have departed from God to some degree. God says to us in Malachi 3: 7, "Return to Me, and I will return to you." If God is not as noticeably present in our lives as once was, it is because we departed from Him in some way.

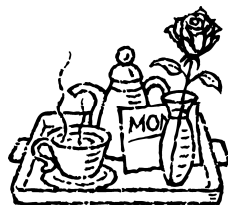
