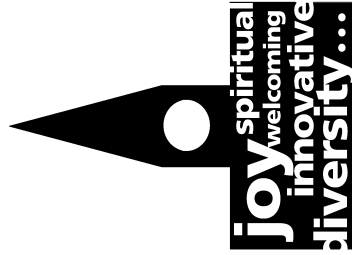

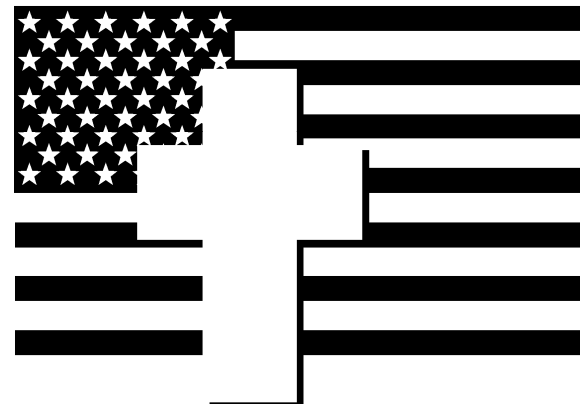

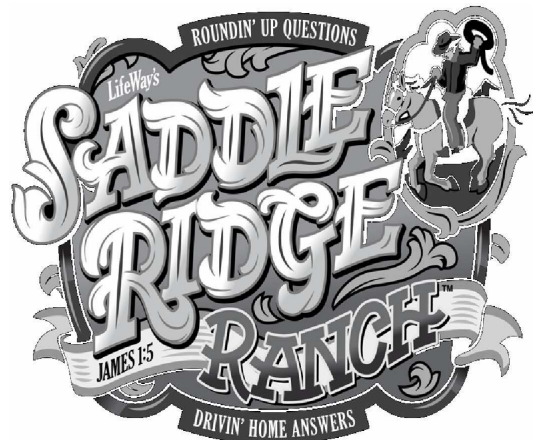

**Casting all your care upon him:
 for he careth for you. 1 Peter 5:7**
