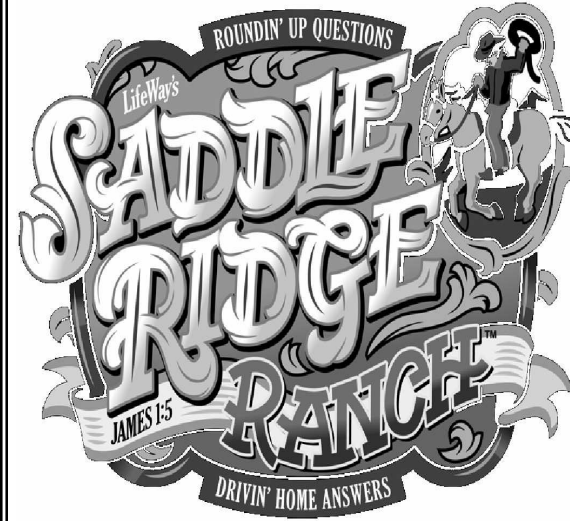

### **How Can I Be Like Christ?**

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus. Philippians 2:5

One day my son and my oldest daughter were combining forces to complete a task given to them by my wife. Their job was to arrange the multitude of children's books they had acquired over their short lifetimes. My daughter, Ashleigh, had taken on the position of leadership and was spouting orders, as any good boss would do. Finally, after the pressure to move quickly had grown too much for my son to bare, he yelled back at her, "Ashleigh, I'm not your slave-ior!"

The innocent twists children give to words often give us a grin and a moment's pause. None of us can be the Savior of the world.

However, Jesus often talked about having a servant's attitude. When we ask, how can we be like Jesus, what is our answer? Jesus gave us some very specific examples we can follow.

Jesus was the Son of God, yet He gathered with followers of God to worship and read the Scripture. Luke 4:16 reports that as usual, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath day." In the very next chapter, Luke records that Jesus often withdrew to quiet places to pray. If Jesus took time to worship with others and spend time in prayer to God, how can we do any less?

Jesus also showed us the attitude we should have toward others. Even when things had been hectic and the group was in need of rest, Jesus had time to look around Him and act compassionately toward others (Mark 6:30-46).

A recent outbreak of tornadoes left many people in our area homeless. One teenage girl felt compassion for a friend who lost everything. Within hours she had organized a plan that provided an outpouring of love and help for her hurting friend. She saw her friend in the same way that Jesus looked with compassion on the crowds who were hurting. Jesus saw their need, felt compassion, and provided help.

Sometimes it's hard to take time out of busy schedules to worship with others, or have quiet time with our Lord. It's also hard to be caring towards others, especially if someone else is a bit bossy. The next time we feel like we are being treated like someone's "slave-ior," we can remember to stop and ask God to help our attitude be like that of Christ Jesus. It'll make the day's work a lot more rewarding.

During your prayer time today, ask God to be with your attitude, especially during the week of VBS. Ask God to help your attitude be like the attitude of Christ.
