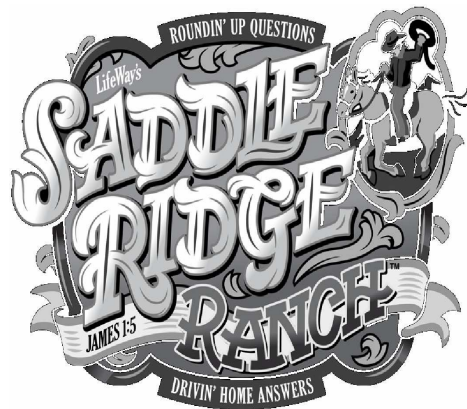


Pastor' Column



Vacation Bible School is off to an amazing start. We had 196 people enrolled in Bible School by the 2nd day. We had 35 middle and high school youths on our first night. As I write this I pray that God will continue to bless the VBS each evening this week.

When you receive this newsletter Vacation Bible School 2010 will be almost over. Now what should we do?

I am glad you asked that. According to our Sunday School Board, the next step after VBS is Follow-Up.

Why Follow-Up?

Follow-up does not need to be complicated, but it does need to be planned for and executed with the same energy and enthusiasm as the rest of VBS.

- Follow-up is important to the life and growth of the church. In Matthew 28, Jesus commands us to share the gospel and follow up after a decision has been made.
- VBS opens doors that lead children and their families into a relationship with Jesus Christ. Follow-up with those who make decisions during VBS helps churches grow and spread the gospel message of Jesus Christ. Follow-up also helps equip new Christians to live the abundant life Christ desires for them.
- Follow-up activities build bridges to unchurched families, hurting parents, and needy children. Follow-up is a crucial element in VBS and everyone can help. This brochure will give you helpful tips for follow-up.

Ways to Follow-up

- Send out VBS 2010 Follow-up Postcards.
- Partner prospects and their families with church members.
- Plan a reunion with the children in your class. Serve your favorite snacks.
- Mail or e-mail newsletters with VBS pictures and information to the homes of children after VBS.
- Invite youth prospects on youth trips and other social events.
- Encourage parents of preschool prospects to participate in Parents' Day Out or in family or parent enrichment activities.
