Randy Alcorn wrote in *The Treasure Principle*:

Treasure Principle- "You can't take it with you- but you can send it on ahead." Ecclesiastes 5: 10-11 in *The Living Bible* says, "He who loves money shall never have enough. The foolishness of thinking that wealth brings happiness! The more you have, the more you spend, right up to the limits of your income, so what is the advantage of wealth-except perhaps to watch it as it runs through your fingers!"

Randy Alcorn paraphrased those verses like this:

"The more you have, the more you want. The more you have, the less you're satisfied. The more you have, the more people (including the government) will come after it. The more you have, the more you have to worry about. The more you have, the more you have to lose. The more you have, the more you'll leave behind.

Tithing isn't the ceiling of giving; it's the floor. Just because God puts His money in our hands doesn't mean He intends for it to stay there! He doesn't want us to have too little or too much." Proverbs 30: 8-9 in *The Living Bible* says, "...Give me neither poverty nor riches! Give me just enough to satisfy my needs! For if I grow rich, I may become content without God. And if I am too poor, I may steal, and thus insult God's holy name." (Underline added) God entrusts us with His money not to build personal kingdoms on earth, but to build His kingdom in heaven. Think about it.
